Growing as Christ's Servants

In his letter to the Philippians (chapter 2:1-11), the apostle Paul pleads with the Christians in Philippi to live in peace with one another and to set aside their personal ambitions to put themselves forward. He tells them to grow as servants of Christ, imitating Christ's servanthood.

In this passage, the apostle Paul points out that Jesus is the supreme example of servanthood. And if they have the same goal, same mind, and same heart as Christ, then they must discard or get rid of self-ambition, and count others more important than themselves. Jesus did that, and so should we.

Although Jesus is God and is equal to the first person of the Trinity (Father), He did not consider equality with the Father as something to cling to. He willingly laid it down for the sake of humanity. Jesus emptied Himself. Meaning, that He put aside His Divinity, His heavenly glory, and was willing to be born as a human. He humbled Himself, taking the very nature of a servant (slave). He was prepared to die a humiliating death on the cross. Jesus humbled Himself, putting the interest of others (yours and mine) above His own. God the Father exalted Jesus through the resurrection and gave Him a name that is above every name – He is called "Lord" ("kurios", master, owner).

The apostle Paul is saying that if Jesus, the King of the universe, the second person of the Trinity, could embrace servanthood, then we who claim to be servants of Christ should grow in that same servanthood which Christ embodied and demonstrated.

A large group of European pastors came to one of D. L. Moody's Northfield Bible Conference in Massachusetts in the late 1800s. Following the European custom of the time, each guest put his shoes outside his room to be cleaned by the hall servants overnight. But Massachusetts, being in America, had no hall servants. Walking the dormitory halls that night, Moody saw the shoes and determined not to embarrass his European Pastors. Moody gathered up the shoes, and, alone in his room, the world-renowned evangelist began to clean and polish the shoes. Only the unexpected arrival of a friend in the midst of the work revealed his secret. Moody never told anyone, but his friend told a few.

As Christ's servants, we should grow in servanthood because we follow the Servant of all - the Lord Jesus Christ.



Prayer Service for the 2023 State Elections

On 11 August 2023, the eve of the state elections for Penang, Kedah, Selangor, Kelantan and Negeri Sembilan, the Methodist churches in Penang gathered together for an evening of intercession and worship. This was hosted at Trinity Methodist Church Penang and jointly organized with the support of Jelutong Chinese Methodist Church (CAC) and the Tamil Methodist Church (TAC).

The service was held in three languages with representatives from various churches leading in the intercessory prayers for the election candidates, the election commission and those in the enforcement, as well as for voters.



Methodist Convention 2023 26-28 August 2023, Kuching Sarawak



The Methodist Church in Malaysia held its Methodist Convention 2023 at UCSI Hotel Kuching from 26 to 28 August 2023. Themed "A Renewed Church", the convention saw a total of 210 participants from six Annual Conferences.

Bishop Dr T. Jeyakumar of The Methodist Church in Malaysia officiated the first day with a service and Holy Communion. He spoke on "A Renewed Church" using the scripture text from 2 Kings 23:1-7. Here, King Josiah instituted major reforms and abolished the worship of foreign gods. The word "renewal" is our desire for conversion and transformation of lives. Bishop Jeyakumar expounded that Methodism defined its mission in terms of renewal. It is a twofold renewal.

- 1. Bringing people from outside the church *into* the church.
- 2. Renewing the hearts and minds of those *inside* the church from spiritual slumber.

There are 4 main areas for renewal:

1. Empowering churches - being word-centred people, carrying out ministries, being mission minded and thinking of the indigenous church

- 2. Enriching families faith formation as the cornerstone of the home; family devotions
- 3. Enhancing education uniting the next generation through education in our Methodist schools and offering the best education at affordable costs
- 4. Engaging the nation the Church to be united as one voice and to build godly and exemplary leaders in nation building

Bishop Jeyakumat then challenged participants as to what is God saying to the Methodist Church in Malaysia?

Mr Tim Cheng, CEO of Taiwan Christian Tribune spoke on "Empowering Churches through Media" providing appropriate and applicable tips on how churches can move with the times and use technology to empower itself and its ministries. Time and the world is continually evolving. The emphasis is that the Church must change to make itself relevant to the world and in doing God's work. The Church must transform itself if it is to impact society and the nation.

Mr Eugene Yapp, a senior fellow at the Institute for International Religious Freedom, shared about "Secularism Threat to Christian Values" and "Engaging the Nation." The Church has a role to play in understanding the social trends of society, getting involved in community empowerment and collaborating to form strategic partnerships with people of other religious groups for projects of common good.

Finally, Pastor Matthew Ling, Certified Family Life Educator, involved in global leadership of family movement spoke on "Family Renewal" stressing that families is where discipleship takes place (Ephesians 5:21-6:9) and where ministries can be developed (1 Tim 3:4-5). But before family renewal can take place, we must first acknowledge that there is a problem is there a "disconnect" between the church and the home? How important is the family unit? Is there a decline in our church families? In a spontaneous survey, he raised the following questions for reflection:

- How important are the families to MCM's renewal?
- · How much are our families contributing to MCM's renewal?
- How serious will the decline be for MCM if nothing is being done to help the families soon?

These practical yet pertinent questions are really food for thought and if we want to see our churches grow and be transformed, we must first start at the root - our families. Both church and families have to work together to establish ways in which each will help the other to grow. Churches can help parents in discipling their children and providing support for parents in helping them nurture their children. Parents themselves too need to be their own children's role models in the ways of following Christ.

In closing the convention, Bishop Jeyakumar challenged all participants with a call for a "Personal Renewal" with our Lord Jesus Christ. It was a very poignant and significant moment. For any renewal to take place, it has to begin with us. We need to be obedient and heed His call; to be a 'renewed people' - Christ-centred and Word-centred.

The Methodist Convention 2023 may have ended but the work has only just begun. It is hoped that all who participated will return to their local churches and start the much-needed work to begin the renewal process.

We praise God for enabling the quadrennial Methodist Convention 2023 to take place after waiting 3 long years due to the Covid pandemic and lockdowns. It was wonderful to see the Methodist family congregating as one - from Peninsula and East Malaysia - everyone came to worship and praise God in various languages, learn and share from one another, make new friends, rekindle old friendships, accept one another despite our diverse backgrounds. Truly, all praise be to God!



Participants in a time of personal renewal

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

Admission to the musical concert was granted with a donation of RM100 per person. An Invitation to a Spiritual Engagement

A young man was wondering how he can get enlisted in the army to be able to fight for his country. He went to the army barracks nearby his house and inquired to the officer there. They informed him that he needed to apply and fulfil the requirements before he can be enlisted. He immediately requested for the form and the officer concerned told him he needed to wait for the advertisement that would appear in the local papers. The young man was asked to follow the instructions that will appear in the advertisement. After prodding further, the young man was surprised to find out that the advertisement would appear only once a year. He was curious and asked if they really needed more recruits or not. The officer calmly replied that it's the procedure and there was no way to change the system in place.

Guess what? The young man was surprised with the response because he was eager to respond when he saw the news flash and the call made by the government for young people to come forward to become soldiers. Instead, over here, he was asked to wait for the advertisement. He didn't understand why the need for all the procedures which, to him, seemed to be hindrances rather than encouragement. His zeal and passion to become a soldier became dampened and he went back home dejected and discouraged.

This short illustration may seem very obvious to you and me. Why did the young man become dejected and discouraged? Didn't he understand the instructions given to him by the army officer? Let us look at the scriptures and see how we respond to the call to be enlisted as the good soldier of Christ Jesus. All of us are enlisted as soldiers in this spiritual battle against the flesh, the world and Satan. We have received many orders from our Commanding Officer, our Lord Jesus Christ. He has empowered us with the Holy Spirit and given us the everlasting and eternal sword which is double edged, the Living Word of God. The amazing quality of all His endearing are they will not deplete in power or prowess, rather

the POWER of the HOLY SPIRT, the PRECISION and PENETRATION of the SWORD which is the LIVING WORD does not weaken overtime or become overused but rather they will become more powerful and more penetrating as you increase its use.

Below we take a look at 3 of those commands we have received as soldiers of our Lord Jesus Christ;

A. 2 Timothy 2:3 - Endure hardship like a good soldier of Christ Jesus

This scripture portion clearly gives us the mandate to endure hardship like a good soldier. Hardship is a must in the life of a soldier. No one is exempt from it. The fact of the matter is you and I may not be able to change our circumstances or what is going on around us. business of life. Whatever that is of worldly affair and care should not entangle the life of a soldier. Your immediate response would be how can we get on with our lives if that was the case? The difference is in getting involved and entangled. Jesus prayed for us who are in the world that we would not be of the world (John 17:11.14.16). We do what is necessary for survival but our primary care and concern should be towards our mission as the soldier of Christ Jesus. Jim Elliott's life verse clearly depicts how a soldier must be, "He is no fool who gives up what he cannot keep to gain what he cannot lose". It is not easy to get an eternal view of things until you and I admit that everything here on earth are temporal. Our citizenship is not here on earth. This is just a temporal abode. And therefore, let us set our minds on things above (Colossians 3:2).

C. 2 Timothy 2:4 - Serve as a soldier to please your commanding officer

What is our mission as a soldier of Christ Jesus? Is it to slay the demons and does our worth depend

on the number of people we delivered? Friends, our call is to Christ. We need to understand what it really means before we can please our commanding officer. Jesus Christ loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood. He made us to serve God and Father. Glory and power be to Jesus Christ for ever and ever. Once we understand that we have been set free for the sole purpose of serving our Almighty God that through our service, we shall glorify Him, then we will comprehend that it is all for Christ. We serve not because it feels good, or somebody else makes us feel good with their praises and accolades but because all things were created through Christ and for Christ (Colossians 1:16).

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Trip to Türkiye 4-16 August 2023

In response to the 2023 Türkiye-Syria Earthquake which struck on 6 February 2023, Methodist Crisis Relief and Development (MCRD) swiftly partnered with various organizations to establish relief and rehabilitation projects in vulnerable communities affected by the disaster. A mission trip was organized from 4-16 August 2023 with the aims to (1) evaluate ongoing projects, (2) conduct needs assessments, (3) form new partnerships, and (4) provide crucial assistance to earthquake survivors in the Adiyaman and Hatay regions. The team comprised Leonidas Woo (leader), Sam Tee (Uncle Button), Simon Kong (photographer) and Samuel Chiam (coordinator).

Upon arriving in Adiyaman, the team visited a Türkiye citizen camp, a Syrian refugee camp, and several mountainous villages to assess their communities' needs. MCRD had provided for a "Mini Library" project in the Syrian refugee camp, which afforded a safe and comfortable learning space for over 30 children to continue their education. Classes were conducted by volunteer teachers daily to educate the children.

The team then travelled to various areas in Hatay to conduct assessment and distribute goods to those in need. Among these efforts, there was a temporary education centre in Samandag that MCRD and Mercy Malaysia collaborated to establish. Since its establishment in March 2023, the education centre has accommodated 700 children.

Subsequently, the team stayed in a temporary refugee camp in the Expo Park of Iskenderun, where MCRD collaborated with Iskenderun Bible Church ("IBC") to provide relief. During their

stay, MCRD and IBC visited affected areas and discussed potential collaborations for rehabilitation programmes. During these visits, Uncle Button performed clown shows and hosted workshops for children, bringing smiles, laughter, and joy to all at the sites. Throughout the mission trip, the team saw numerous damaged, collapsed or demolished buildings, creating a landscape filled with sand and dust. Affected communities were scattered near hazardous structures and makeshift camps for shelter. During interviews with Türkiye residents, they expressed a sense of helplessness, especially for those without economic means who were forced to reside in temporary accommodation such as container houses, portable buildings, and tents. Despite some basic needs being met, significant challenges remained, and the emotional wounds of the people needed healing. Nevertheless, they expressed immense gratitude to the team for visiting,

acknowledging their situation, and responding to their needs. Particularly in remote areas, during MCRD visitation, residents were deeply touched that someone from a foreign land remembered them and was willing to travel overseas to assist. Additionally, some villagers requested Bibles, attended Sunday services and even chose to follow Jesus.

The team gives thanks to God for ensuring their safety throughout the trip. They also extend their appreciation to all those who supported them along the way and express gratitude to those who partnered with MCRD to assist vulnerable populations.

MCRD has heard the needs of the people and intends to continue working in Türkiye with the ultimate goal of addressing their challenges and sharing the love of Jesus Christ with their hearts and actions. Glory be to God!




